

The Plight Of Millions Of Palestinian Refugees Is Hidden In Plain View



In her first on-the-ground report "Inside Palestine's Refugee Camps", Abby Martin of [The Empire Files](#), gives an eye-opening look at two of the most attacked refugee camps in the West Bank of Palestine: Balata (near Nablus) and Aida (near Bethlehem) camps.
