Catholic Patriarch Stages Sympathy Hunger Strike in Solidarity with Palestinians

<u>Alwaght News reported</u>:] Catholic Leader went on a one-day hunger strike on Saturday in solidarity with over 1,500 Palestinian prisoners, who have staged an open-ended hunger strike in Israeli jails in protest at the administrative detention policy and harsh prison conditions.
